Purpose: To provide guidance in developing content for RNANT/NU newsletter.

Policy:

- (1) The Registered Nurses Association of the Northwest Territories and Nunavut newsletter will primarily be a communication mechanism between the Association and its members:
 - a) To provide a medium through which the RNANT/NU members and others are informed about the policies, objectives and activities of the RNANT/NU.
 - b) To be a reliable source of information on trends and issues facing the nursing profession and health care at a community, jurisdictional and national level.
