This bylaw results from:

- (a) section 61 of the Nursing Profession Act which requires the Executive Director to maintain a public registry of decisions of Boards of Inquiry and appeal committees; and
- (b) section 37 (3) of the Act which deems the terms and conditions of a settlement of a complaint to be orders of a Board of Inquiry under sections 47 (2) and 48 of the Act.

SECTION 1 Definitions

In this bylaw

- (a) "Act" shall mean the Nursing Profession Act S.N.W.T. 2003, c. 15 as amended;
- (b) "Alternate Dispute Resolution" means an alternative dispute resolution process conducted under section 37 of the Act;
- (c) "Board of Inquiry" means a board of inquiry designated under section 41 of the Act to hear a complaint about a nurse; and
- (d) "nurse" shall mean "nurse" as defined in section 30 (1) of the Act.

SECTION 2 Contents of Public Register

The Public Register shall include:

- (a) decisions made by a Board of Inquiry concerning a nurse;
- (b) orders made by a Board of Inquiry concerning a nurse including any terms or conditions made by a Board of Inquiry or about that nurse; and
- (c) any terms or conditions made about a nurse included in a settlement reached pursuant to Alternate Dispute Resolution concerning that nurse.
- (d) any finding, order, direction or decision made by the Professional Conduct Appeals Committee.
