## Continuous Learning Activities Examples

When completing your online CCP, you will be required to start your CCP prior to online renewal which you will then complete during renewal and will start your CCP for the next registration year. You may be required to provide proof of completion during the yearly audit, you can upload the certificates in the online environment.

Re-certification is required for employment and part of the expectation to keep current in your practice and does not count towards CCP.</p>

All activities must be related to nursing and fall under the domains of nursing and/or standards of practice.
