Can NP's prescribe Buprenorphine?

NPs can prescribe this Schedule I drug if they have the competence to do so. There is no legislative barrier preventing NP's from prescribing buprenorphine in the NT/NU.

As with any drug RNANTNU requires NP's to adhere to the legislation, regulatory standards and employer policies when prescribing.

Although RNANT/NU is not requesting to see proof of course completion, an NP should complete (and have proof of completion) of an evidence-informed learning module on buprenorphine, before prescribing it. The following two educational opportunities are available
